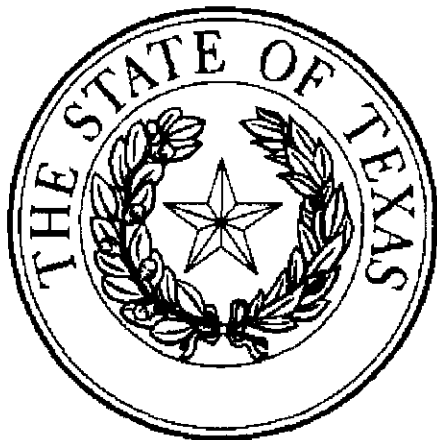

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF CRAWFORD GLOBAL CABLE, L.L.C. Corporations Section**

Linda Crawford, a natural person of the age 18 years or older, adopts the following Articles of Organization for a limited liability company under the Texas Limited Liability Company Act:

ARTICLE I

The name of the limited liability company is set forth below:

CRAWFORD GLOBAL CABLE, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II

The initial registered agent of the Company is an individual resident of the state. The name of the initial registered agent of the Company is Linda Crawford.

The business address of the initial registered agent for the Company and the Company's initial registered office address is 411 Lakeview Street, Whitehouse, Texas, 75791.

ARTICLE III

The Company will be member-managed. The Company will not have managers. Management of the Company is reserved to the members. The names and addresses of the initial members of the Company are set forth below:

ARTICLE IV

The period of duration of the Company shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

The purpose for which the limited liability company is organized is to transact any or all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized.

ARTICLE VI

Except as to the extent the Regulations specifically provide otherwise a member shall not be liable for the debts, obligations or liabilities of the Company including under a judgment, decree or order of a court.

ARTICLE VII

The number of authorized membership units of the Company shall be 1,000 (One Thousand), for which each member will be entitled to full benefits and privileges of such membership, subject to duties and obligations, as more fully set forth in the Regulations of the Company.

ARTICLE VIII

The Regulations of the Company may provide that any action required or permitted to be taken at a meeting of members may be taken without a meeting if a written consent thereto shall be signed by members entitled to vote thereon having not less than the minimum number of votes that would be necessary to take such action at a meeting.

ARTICLE IX

The Articles of Organization may be amended from time to time as provided in the Regulations of the Company.

ARTICLE X

This document will become effective when the document is filed by the Secretary of State.
