#### 7. Note Payable

During the year ended June 30, 2005, a donor loaned the Association \$170,000 to purchase 100 Wildcat statues to be sold as part of the lifetime membership package offered to alumni. The note does not bear interest. Under the terms of the arrangement, the Association is making payments to the donor at the rate of \$1,700 for each statue sold with a lifetime membership. As of June 30, 2005, a total of twelve statues had been sold and the Association had repaid \$5,100. The remaining \$15,300 due was repaid during August 2005. The balance due on the note as of June 30, 2005 was \$164,900. The entire balance is classified as long-term since the Association us unable to predict the rate at which lifetime memberships will be sold.

#### 8. Transactions with Related Entities

#### University of Arizona

The Association has an administrative agreement with the Arizona Board of Regents for and on behalf of the University of Arizona. Under the terms of the agreement, the Association and the University of Arizona have certain obligations to each other. The University of Arizona agrees to provide the Association with services, supplies, staff, support, office space and financial support. During the year ended June 30, 2005, the University of Arizona provided the Association with allocated support of \$1,603,816 and in-kind rent of \$151,659.

# University of Arizona Foundation

The University of Arizona Alumni Association and the University of Arizona Foundation collaborate in the development of alumni financial support for the University. The University of Arizona Foundation maintains and manages restricted accounts and the Alumni Endowment for the Alumni Association. In accordance with donor stipulations, the Foundation contributes 4% to the Association based on a three-year rolling average market value of the endowment. During the year ended June 30, 2005, the Association received \$161,884 from this endowment. The fair market value of the Alumni Endowment held by the Foundation was \$3,587,153 at June 30, 2005.

#### 9. Related Party Transactions

During the year ended June 30, 2005, in-kind services were donted by two members of the board of directors. One board member donated investment management fees of \$3,000 and the other paid premiums on a general insurance policy for the Association in the amount of \$10,993.

#### 10. Commitments

During the year ended June 30, 2005, the Association entered into an agreement with Harris Internet Services to provide specialty internet service applications. The agreement requires the Association to make annual payments of \$34,000 through April 2010 when the agreement expires. The Association may cancel the agreement at any time by providing 60 days written notice to Harris Internet Services and paying a cancellation fee equal to 25% of the remaining scheduled payments under the agreement. As of June 30, 2005, the Association had not cancelled the agreement.
