#### 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies, Continued

#### Concentration of Credit Risk

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) insures cash accounts at banks up to \$100,000. Investments held by other institutions are covered up to \$500,000 under insurance provided by the Securities Investor Protection Corporation (SIPC). However, SIPC does not protect against losses in market value. It is the opinion of management that the solvency of the referenced financial institutions is not of concern at this time. At June 30, 2006 and 2005, the Association had cash and investments in the amount of \$3,101,836 and \$2,391,843, respectively, at various banks and institutions in excess of FDIC and SIPC limitations.

#### Income Taxes

The Association is exempt from income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. However, income from advertising activities not directly related to the Organization's tax-exempt purpose may be subject to taxation as unrelated business income. Income tax expense for such unrelated business income totaled \$-0- and \$6,315 for the years ended June 30, 2006 and 2005, respectively.

#### 3. Guaranteed Royalty Payments Receivable

Guaranteed royalty payments receivable represents amounts due to the Association under its long-term royalty agreement with MBNA America Bank, N.A. Under the terms of the agreement, the Association will receive a total of \$5,300,000 in guaranteed payments. The balance as of June 30, 2006 represents the net present value of the remaining payments to be received under this agreement. Future guaranteed royalty payments to be received are:

#### 7. Note Payable

During the year ended June 30, 2005, a donor loaned the Association \$170,000 to purchase 100 Wildcat statues to be sold as part of the lifetime membership package offered to alumni. The note does not bear interest. Under the terms of the arrangement, the Association made payments to the donor at the rate of \$1,700 for each statue sold with a lifetime membership. The balance due on the note as of June 30, 2005 was \$164,900.

During the year ended June 30, 2006, the Association repaid the donor \$64,900. The donor forgave the remaining note balance of \$100,000, and there is no balance due on the note payable as of June 30, 2006.
