Article 2
Purpose
The purpose of this non-profit corporation is to organize Marine Corps
League Casa Grande Detachment 901 Inc. as a subsidiary organization of the National Marine Corps League which is a nonprofit incorporated by an act of the 75th Congress of the United States of America.

Article 3 Character of Affairs

All Detachment policy and proce-All Detachment policy and procedures will be in accordance with guidance issued by National Headquarters and the Department of Arizona Marine Corps League. This Corporation (a) shall have perpetual succession; (b) may charge and collect membership that and procedure contributions of may charge and collect membership dues and receive contributions of money or property to be devoted to carrying out the purpose of the Marine Corps League; (c) may adopt and alter by-laws not Inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of the United States, the State of Arizona or the Marine Corps League; (d) may establish and maintain offices for the conduct of business: (e) may appoint or elect Ilsh and maintain offices for the conduct of business; (e) may appoint or elect officers and agents to conduct the business and exercise the powers of the corporation; (f) may acquire by purchase, devise, bequest, gift or otherwise, and hold encumber, convey, or otherwise dispose of such real and personal property as may be necessary or appropriate for its corporate purposes; and of generally may do any and all and g) generally may do any and all lawful acts necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes for which the corporation is created.

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, direcbe distributable to its frienders, discreters, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 2 and under Section 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of processed. shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to inituence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any or in opposition of any candidate for public office. Nothing in the preceding shall prohibit the Marine Corps League Casa Grande Detachment 90 Inc. or any subdivision thereof, from participating in political issues affecting the welfare of the United States Marine shall be the carrying on of propaganda the welfare of the United States Marine Corps, the National Security of our Nation, or any veterans' claims for justice arising from service in the Armed Forces of the United States of America. Notwithstanding any other provision of notwinstancing any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation or by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) of the

Internal Revenue Code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after tion, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of its assets to the Marine Corps League Department of Arizona or the assets are to be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws). Any such asset not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of Pinal County exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which is organized and operated exclusively for such purpose under section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the correspondence of the Court o sponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

Article 6 Indemnification

Except as provided by law, the members, directors and officers of the corporation shall not be liable for the debts and obligations of the corporation. The corporation may indemnify any person who incurs expenses by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a member, director, officer, or agent or the corporation in all circumstances in which such indemnification is permitted by
