ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

OF

WORKER POWER (Formerly CASE ACTION FUND)

An Arizona Nonprofit Corporation

The undersigned initial incorporators on this day associate themselves with the following nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Arizona and do adopt the following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

<u>Name</u>: The name of the corporation, formerly CASE Action Fund, is Worker Power (hereinafter the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to promote social welfare within the meaning of section 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, but not limited to. undertaking projects and advocating for policies to promote fairness for American families.

ARTICLE III

<u>Character of Affairs</u>: The character of affairs of the Corporation will be to register voters. build civic engagement, advocate for policies and officials that will generate decent jobs at fair wages, and demand civil and economic rights.

ARTICLE IV

- (a) The term of existence of this Corporation shall be perpetual.
- (b) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II. Notwithstand-ing any other provision of these Articles. the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(4) of the United States Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- (c) The corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit.
- (d) Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all its assets exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or

scientific purpose as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under sections 50l(c)(3) or 50l(c)(4) of the United States Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of by the Board of Directors shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located. exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Any instruments required to convey the assets and funds of this, Corporation upon its dissolution or liquidation shall be made and executed by its Chairman acting last before its dissolution or by a trustee appointed for such purpose by the by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located.

ARTICLE V

The initial board of directors shall consist of two directors. The names and addresses of persons who are to serve as the directors until the first annual meeting of the meeting of the Board of Directors are:

The number of persons to serve on the Board of Directors shall be thereafter fixed in the ByLaws.
