- 16. On February 19, 2022, Plaintiff was present at said location as an invitee after pulling into the parking lot due to a vehicle stall. On said date, Defendants **AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC.** threatened Plaintiffs' safety with a broom, baseball bat, and gun, then proceeded to physically assault, batter, accost, and harm Plaintiffs with said baseball bat, thereby causing substantial injury to Plaintiffs.
- 17. Due to Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC.'s intentional, reckless, and/or negligent conduct, Plaintiffs LUIS AYALA and ANGELICA AYALA were injured and damaged, and therefore

incurred monetary expense.

18. As a proximate result of the actions of Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC., Plaintiffs LUIS AYALA and ANGELICA AYALA sustained severe personal injuries, suffered emotional distress, pain and suffering, as well as incurred medical, property and other special damages, and other losses and miscellaneous expenses in amounts to be proven at trial.

## **COUNT ONE: ASSAULT AND BATTERY**

## (As to all Defendants)

- 19. Plaintiff incorporates all previous paragraphs and allegations herein by reference as if fully set forth herein.
- 20. Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC., intentionally touched Plaintiffs in a harmful or offensive manner; and intentionally acted in a manner which caused Plaintiffs reasonable apprehension that he would be touched in a harmful or offensive manner.
- Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR
   FOOD MART, INC. intentionally physically accosted Plaintiffs.
- 22. The harmful or offensive touching by Defendants, as referenced above, is the legal and proximate cause of Plaintiff's damages, which include but are not limited to property damage, physical injuries, pain and suffering since the incident, past and future medical expenses, loss of earnings, and mental and emotional anguish, all in an amount to be determined at trial.

## COUNT TWO: NEGLIGENCE

## (As to all Defendants)

- 23. Plaintiff incorporates all previous paragraphs and all allegations herein by reference as if fully set forth herein.
- 24. Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC. owed a duty of reasonable care to Plaintiffs LUIS AYALA and ANGELICA AYALA to not cause unreasonable and/or undue harm to Plaintiffs.
- 25. Defendants **AHMAD ZEITOUN**, **CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC.** breached this duty of care toward Plaintiff when they behaved in a verbally and/or physically aggressive manner, physically accosting Plaintiff.
- 26. Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC.'s breach of this duty is the legal and proximate cause of Plaintiff's damages, which include but are not limited to property damage, physical injuries, pain and suffering since the incident, past and future medical expenses, loss of earnings, and mental and emotional anguish, all in an amount to be determined at trial.

# COUNT THREE: NEGLIGENT HIRING, TRAINING, RETENTION AND SUPERVISION

## (As to All Defendants)

27. Plaintiff incorporates all previous paragraphs and all allegations herein by reference as if fully set forth herein.

28. Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR
FOOD MART, INC., through their duly authorized agents, servants and employees, were
negligent for hiring agents, officers and employees who may have been inadequately qualified
and/or experienced for their positions; failing to adequately train agents, officers and employees
who worked at their organizations; failing to adequately supervise agents, officers and employees
who worked at their organizations; failing to reasonably discipline agents, officers and employees
who worked at their organizations for any improper conduct prior to the subject accident; failing
to terminate agents, officers and employees, who worked at their organizations for inadequate
performance prior to the subject incident; and/or implementing, maintaining and/or tolerating
policies, practices and customs which contributed to the improper and negligent of agents, officers
and employees, who worked at the said organizations.

29. Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC.'s breach of this duty is the legal and proximate cause of Plaintiff's damages, which include but are not limited to physical injuries, pain and suffering since the accident, past and future medical expenses, loss of earnings, and mental and emotional anguish, all in an amount to be determined at trial.

## **COUNT FOUR: PUNITIVE DAMAGES**

## (As to all Defendants)

- 30. Plaintiffs incorporate all previous paragraphs and allegations set forth above as if fully alleged herein.
- 31. Upon information and belief, Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC. acted to serve their own

interests, having reason to know and consciously disregarding a substantial risk that their conduct might significantly injure others.

- 32. And/or Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or24 HR FOOD MART, INC. consciously pursued a course of conduct knowing that it created a substantial risk of significant harm to others.
- 33. Whereby, Defendants AHMAD ZEITOUN, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. and/or 24 HR FOOD MART, INC. acted with an evil mind, and by reason thereof, Plaintiff demands exemplary and punitive damages against the Defendants in a reasonable amount.

## PRAYER FOR RELIEF

- 4. For punitive damages in an amount sufficient to punish Defendants and to deter similar conduct by Defendants in the future.
- 5. For costs of suit herein and for such other and further relief as the court deems just and proper.


